House Bill 2578: Real Property; Purchaser Dwelling Actions (Construction Defect) was signed into law by Governor Ducey on March 23, 2015. This legislation addresses residential construction defect litigation and makes three critical changes to the current Purchaser Dwelling Act. The builder is given the "right to repair" alleged defects, a new definition of "construction defect" is provided, and the section providing for an award of attorneys' fees and expert witness fees to the prevailing party has been deleted. The combination of these changes should have an impact on the claims experience (and liability premiums) in the construction defect arena. Get the skinny on all the modifications this new law will make to construction defect litigation and the impact on the insurance industry.
