2019 Ethics #1 – 3 Hour Combo Courses

FREE Member Benefit Seminar for all IIABAZ members.

The first hour from 9:00 -10:00 A.M. is a course called **Ethics – Straight Talk**. In today's business world of communication and marketing, it is sometimes easy to over promise or exaggerate on a website or other marketing pieces. This "Straight Talk" seminar examines the ethics of over promising in the marketing of services and policies for an agent/agency. We will focus specifically on Websites during this sixty-minute seminar reviewing how (what appear to be) innocent statements could be misleading to the consumer. This seminar will also be helpful to agents that review the websites/marketing material for their clients to spot "over promising".

The final two hours from 10:00 A.M. to 12:00 PM is called **Commercial Insurance – Here's Your Library Card**. So many times, as an insurance agent, we are faced with questions of the right thing to do. In this session, we will go through examples of ethical dilemmas and how to find the resources to get answers. Sometimes it is being aware when the agent is facing an Ethical dilemma (to know what you don't know). Next is knowing where to find the resources. We will be looking at the core of getting into a problem sometimes found in policies that are not ISO (the standard of policy forms) as well as endorsements that can drastically change the course of a well-known policy.

NOTE: Unless you are exempt from CE, you are required to take 6 hours of Ethics CE in order to renew your Arizona insurance license every four years. Please be sure keep track of your Ethics credits and be sure you are not duplicating any seminars. This entire program is brand new, and has never been offered in Yuma before.
