



Anatomy of a Lawsuit – FREE Agency Member Benefit Webinar

We all know that insurance disputes can end up in court. But how are those disputes resolved through litigation? This session explains the court process and examines the insurance issues that can arise in the context of an auto accident, including potential errors and omissions claims against insurance producers. The case study deals with issues of liability in an auto accident, the application of Arizona's "Family Purpose Doctrine", and possible deficiencies in coverage for injuries resulting from the accident. These issues arise both in the context of Arizona statutes governing the offer of certain coverages such as uninsured and underinsured motorist coverage, as well as standard of care questions for insurance producers involved in the sale of coverage to the parties.

This program will help untangle legal issues in accident cases and show how they can sometimes result in insurance producer errors and omissions claims. We also discuss best practices for producers who want to avoid being caught up in accident-related litigation.
